**Correspondence: MOVED** that inwards be received and outwards approved Ian/Barbara. **CARRIED** MDC Cemetery Fees and Charges – Barbara felt that the charges were too high and would put added pressure on families already dealing with the grief of losing a loved one. Pelorus Promotions request for a Selfie Board – this project does not fit within the activities of Havelock Vision 2020 (priorities on Youth and Community well-being). The focus is on tourism. It would be more appropriate for a local business to sponsor this.

The 2019/20 budget was approved, and Susan will add this into MYOB so that reporting can include budget analysis.

Motion: To increase the Administrators hourly rate to \$30.00. Barbara/Ian CARRIED.

**Tumble Tots-** At the end of the 2018/19 financial year it was discovered that there were surplus funds valuing \$150.00. New equipment has been purchased with these funds.

**Tai Chi** – A flier drop has been completed through the local postie including rural areas. There has been one person ask for more information on the class. It is hoped that the flier drop will remind people that the class is still running.

**Youth Activity** – Looking at running a variety of activities over winter, spring and into summer for youth. Barbara has obtained a quote from Sea Kayaking Adventures to run a kayak program and a mountain bike option (tabled). Barbara also discussed the Mountain bike program running at Jentree which Susan has been investigating. This would be a good option as instructor and area come highly recommended.

Next steps will be to put together a calendar of events with approximate costs then approach Rory at Sport Tasman to find out what funding is available and how it can be used effectively. Ian asked about the health and safety aspect of running a program which rely partly on parents volunteering their time. Susan has discussed this with Rory who is putting together the appropriate forms and will give advice on the best way of doing this.

Susan has approached the Havelock School about the possibility of hiring the community van to transport groups to these activities. The van can seat up to 12 people and is a reasonable price to hire.

Barbara has also talked with Glen Lambeth about the possibility of running an orienteering program.
