Community Nursery – The irrigation is being set up. Once this is complete Muff would like to organise restocking of the plants. Outward Bound students will be spending a day helping soon.

Havelock Birdsong – Sandra emailed through an update (tabled). Harcourts will sponsor the project with the proviso that when a house in Havelock is sold by Harcourts they will donate \$500.00. The Pub Charity grant has been spent and the accountability report will be completed shortly. Pat was concerned that the role of Havelock Vision 2020 in this project has not been clearly explained to the members of Havelock Birdsong. A Memorandum of Understanding will be put together to provide clarity for both groups.

Youth Activity – Outward Bound responded to a request to discuss the idea of running a joint activity with HV2020 (tabled). Barbara would like to wait until a response is received from Sport Tasman to find out what funding is available before taking this any further. Rory is expected to come back with a result on Sport Tasman funding by Friday 21st June.

Barbara has had a talk with Glen Lambeth about running an orientation activity. He is available later in the year. He may also be able to help with a mountain bike activity. Muff has a possible lead to another instructor who may help with mountain biking.

Ian mentioned that there is a group of youth traveling through to Blenheim from Rai Valley to attend Judo classes and asked if it would be possible to help provide funding assistance for this group. The Sport NZ Rural Travel Fund is available and may fit this situation.

New Trustee – Barbara has spoken with Julia Pointon about becoming a Trustee. She is interested but wanted to discuss the idea with the HCA before confirming.

Havelock Vision 2020 Name Change – Next year will be 2020 so it would be appropriate to rename the charitable trust. Ideas were welcomed (Ian-HV2040, Pat -Think Tank). It would be a good opportunity to celebrate the work that has been completed to date and what the aims are for the future as well as announcing the new name.
